The bridge between the past and the future at the Rowland Theatre will be paved with bricks!

In celebration of its 100th anniversary in 2017, the Rowland Theatre is restoring its marquee to the original 1917 glass structure. A plaza consisting of engraved bricks will be designed in front of the theatre to help fund this project.



Charles Hedding Rowland opened the doors to the magnificent Rowland Theatre in downtown Philipsburg on June 4, 1917, for a showing of the silent movie, "Within the Law."

On the eve of the theatre's 100th anniversary, the Rowland Theatre's Board of Directors is asking for your help to preserve the past, and, at the same time, launch the playhouse toward its second century of serving the residents of the Moshannon Valley and beyond.

In 1917, the original glass marquee extended over the roadway about two feet. The board will be restoring the marquee to its original glass structure and size.

In conjunction with the new glass canopy, a plaza will be designed in front of the theatre to protect the new structure. This plaza, which will extend the sidewalk, will consist of engraved bricks.

In keeping with the original design of the 1917 marquee, the movie and event advertising will not be done on the glass canopy. Instead, a digital standing marquee will be placed on the plaza.
